Accreditation Workgroup

- Report on Model Accreditation Standards for Higher Education Programs for Students with Intellectual Disabilities
- The new Workgroup met in Washington DC on March 2017.
- Established 3 Committees
 - Accreditation Outreach Committee focus on outreach to accrediting agencies, recommendations regarding a possible registry, and research on accreditation policies and process
 - The Student Learning Outcomes Committee will research student competencies, learning, employment and other outcomes
 - The Self-Study Development Committee's purpose is to develop recommendations for a protocol and plans for field-testing the standards via a self study process
